Scholarship Renewals, Non-Renewals or Reductions

Here are a few reminders for you to as you complete your team's forms:

- Athletically related financial aid may be offered for a period of one academic year.
- NC State requires appropriate documentation when a Head Coach recommends a non-renewal or reduction in aid. This would include a warning that provides a specific explanation of the problem and the Coach's expectations for the student-athlete to change his/her behavior.
- Verbal warnings issued to student-athletes that could lead to a non-renewal or reduction in aid must be made with a sport administrator present. Written warnings should be sent to your sport specific sport administrator and Scott.
- The Director of Financial Aid approves all non-renewal or reductions in athletically related financial aid.
- All notices of renewal, non-renewal or reduction must be made by July 1 (NCAA Bylaw 15.3.3.1).
- Student-athletes have the right to appeal the non-renewal or reduction as long as it is made and reviewed in accordance with the procedures established by the University for financial aid appeals by all members of the student body.

Athletically Related Financial Aid Renewals/Non-renewals are due April 24th.

There are only two exceptions to this date:

1. You are still in season. If this is the case, please contact Scott Byrd so we can determine a deadline date for you. OR,
2. You need more time to make a decision on a particular student. If this is the case, please contact Scott Byrd so we can make an alternative deadline.

Unless the Compliance Office is contacted to make arrangements for an alternative deadline, the Compliance Office will make the recommendation to the Financial Aid Office to renew the athletic grant-in-aid.

Reminders...

Monthly Paperwork:
Compliance paperwork is due on the 10th of each month. This includes practice logs and all official visit paperwork for the previous month.

Official Visits:
Please use the most recent Official Visit forms, available on the Compliance website or in the Compliance Office. Remember, a transcript, test scores, and verification of registration with the Eligibility Center prior must be obtained prior to approval.

National Letter of Intent

There are several upcoming NLI Signing Periods.

- All Other Sports Regular Period: April 8-August 1, 2009
 - April 6-9 is a Dead Period for these sports.
 - This includes: Baseball, Softball, Golf (M&W), Rifle, Swimming & Diving (M&W), Tennis, Gymnastics, Volleyball and Wrestling
- Basketball (Men's & Women's) Regular Period: April 15-May 20, 2009
 - April 13-16 is a Dead Period for these sports.

Reminders:

- Turn Scholarship Request Form into the Compliance Office at least ONE WEEK before you would like to mail out the NLI and scholarship letter.
- Express Mail can be used to send the NLI packet to the prospect. The prospect (and parent/legal guardian) should sign both copies of the NLI and Athletics Scholarship Agreement. They should send one copy of the NLI and the yellow and pink copies of the Athletics Scholarship Agreement (prospect keeps the white copy) back to you.
- The NLI must be signed within 14 days of issuance. NCSU must submit the NLI to the ACC office within 21 days of the final signature. If either of these dates passes, the NLI becomes null and void.
- If an NLI becomes null and void, or invalid for any other reason, NCSU must notify the student and the ACC in writing within 5 business days. A second NLI may be issued if time permits within the signing period.
